
SCELSSE SEED FUNDING

Grant Information Sheet

1. INTRODUCTION

The SCELSSE Seed Funding is a continuing program of internal grants that enable SCELSSE researchers to follow potential new leads arising from their research, to evaluate new concepts that could in future grow into the basis of larger external grant applications or be developed in conjunction with other basic or applied research partners. The SCELSSE Seed Funding program is drawn from SCELSSE's core funding budget.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The SCELSSE Seed Funding is open to all Research/Senior Research Fellows and Academics, who have at least 50% appointment in SCELSSE.

3. FUNDING QUANTUM AND DURATION

The SCELSSE Seed Funding program is applicable for small exploratory research projects (either individually or team-based) of total project values of up to **S\$50,000**, over a Term of **no more than 2 years**.

4. APPLICATION SUBMISSION

The SCELSSE Seed Funding Application Form should be duly endorsed and submitted to SCELSSE's Research Committee through Associate Professor Scott Rice (Rscott@ntu.edu.sg), with the subject heading "SCELSSE Seed Funding Application". Proposals for SCELSSE Seed Funding can be submitted at any time. However, each Principal Investigator is only allowed to submit one application at a time.

The application process involves a brief presentation pitch to SCELSSE's Research Committee, which will provide feedback for the applicant to incorporate into a final proposal. The final proposal will then be submitted to SCELSSE's Executive Committee, which will evaluate and give the final approval.

Evaluation will be based upon assessment of creativity, novelty, feasibility and the prospects for seeding novel research programs. Simple extensions to existing programs do not automatically meet these criteria.
